~QUARTUS (14) (Quar'tus) [from Latin, meaning, Fourth]

- One living in Corinth whose greetings Paul included in his letter to the Romans, about 56 C.E.
- Gaius, my host and that of all the congregation, greets you.
 Erastus the city steward greets you, and so does Quartus his brother (Romans 16:23)
- Having a Roman name and knowing the brothers in Rome, he may have formerly been of that congregation.
