

## ~QUESTIONING (51)

[English, quizzical, curious, puzzled, surprised, perplexed, inquiring, querying, inquiring, Opposite of, **answering**]

- Now when his disciples were alone with him later, they **questioned** him regarding the illustrations he had given before to the crowds.
- Now when he got to be alone, those around him with the twelve began **questioning** him on the illustrations. (**Mark 4:10**)
- Now Jesus and his disciples left for the village of Caesarea Philippi and while on the way there Jesus posed the **question** to his disciples; Who are people saying that I am?
- Jesus and his disciples now left for the villages of Caesarea Philippi, and on the way he began **questioning** his disciples, saying to them; Who are men saying that I am? (**Mark 8:27**)
- Here also the Pharisees approached him to put him to the test. This time they tested him with a **question** about the lawfulness of divorce.
- Pharisees now approached and, to put him to the test, began **questioning** him whether it was lawful for a man to divorce a wife. (**Mark 10:2**)
- So Pilate responding to Jesus' silence, again began **questioning** him, asking Jesus if he had nothing to say about the many charges, that were being brought against him by the religious leaders.
- Now Pilate began **questioning** him again, saying; Have you no reply to make? See how many charges they are bringing against you. (**Mark 15:4**)
- So after returning another day's journey back to Jerusalem, they went looking for him and found him on the third day that they had been separated. They then found him in the temple, sitting amidst the teachers there. He was listening to them, and **questioning** them about their teaching.
- Well, after three days they found him in the temple, sitting in the

midst of the teachers and listening to them and **questioning** them. (**Luke 2:46**)
