[English, calmed, silenced, calmed down, became quiet, settled down, Opposite of, roused]

- The Psalmist showed his waiting attitude toward Yehowah God by saying that he was like a weanling who had quieted his soul, perhaps from crying upon a dry breast.
- Surely I have soothed and **quieted** my soul like a weanling upon his mother. My soul is like a weanling upon me. (**Psalms 131:2**)
- The city recorder was in fear of the Roman authorities calling his conduct into question for allowing a riot so he **quieted** the crowd.
- When, finally, the city recorder had **quieted** the crowd, he said, Men of Ephesus, who really is there of mankind that does not know that the city of the Ephesians is the temple keeper of the great Artemis and of the image that fell from heaven? (**Acts of Apostles 19:35**)
