~TABEEL 1 (18) (Tab'e-el) [Good Is God]

- Father of a man whom the kings of Israel and Syria intended to place on the throne in Jerusalem if they captured Judah's capital. The name of the son is not given. The incident occurred during the period when the reigns of Ahaz and Pekah overlapped between about 762 and 759 B.C.E.
- For the reason that Syria with Ephraim and the son of Remaliah has advised what is bad against you, saying; (Isaiah 7:5)
- Let us go up against Judah and tear it apart and by breakthroughs take it for ourselves, and let us make another king reign inside it, the son of Tabeel. (Isaiah 7:6)
