## ~TABOR 3 (28) (Ta'bor)

- The big tree of Tabor was presumably in Benjamin's territory. It was a landmark that Samuel referred to in his instructions to Saul after Saul's anointing, where he was to meet three men en route to Bethel. The site is unknown today.
- Samuel then took the flask of oil and poured it out upon his head and kissed him and said; Is it not because Yehowah has anointed you as a leader over his inheritance? (1 Samuel 10:1)
- On your going away from me today you will certainly find two men close by the tomb of Rachel in the territory of Benjamin at Zelzah, and they will certainly say to you; The she-asses that you have gone to look for have been found, but now your father has given up the matter of the she-asses and has become anxious about you men, saying; What shall I do about my son? (1 Samuel 10:2)
- And you must pass on from there still farther and come as far as the big tree of Tabor, and there there must encounter you three men going up to the true God at Bethel, one carrying three kids and one carrying three round loaves of bread and one carrying a large jar of wine. (1 Samuel 10:3)
