- And Jeremiah began to chant over Josiah, and all the male singers and female singers keep talking about Josiah in their dirges down till today, and they have them set as a regulation over Israel, and there they are written among the dirges. (2 Chronicles 35:25)
- The one covering over transgression is seeking love, and he that keeps talking about a matter is separating those familiar with one another. (Proverbs 17:9)
- And he kept contending with an angel and gradually prevailed.

 He wept, that he might implore favor for himself. At Bethel He got to find him, and there He began talking with us. (Hosea 12:4)
- But he denied it before them all, saying; I do not know what you are talking about. (Matthew 26:70)
- Why is this man talking in this manner? He is blaspheming. Who can forgive sins except one, God? (Mark 2:7)
- These appeared with glory and began talking about his departure that he was destined to fulfill at Jerusalem. (Luke 9:31)
- But he was talking about the temple of his body. (John 2:21)
- They did not grasp that he was talking to them about the Father. (John 8:27)
- I am not talking about all of you. I know the ones I have chosen. But it is in order, that the Scripture might be fulfilled; He that used to feed on my bread has lifted up his heel against me. (John 13:18)
- Hence they were saying; What does this mean that he says, a little while? We do not know what he is talking about. (John 16:18)
- And he was talking and disputing with the Greek-speaking Jews. But these made attempts to do away with him. (Acts of Apostles

- However, out of them there were some men of Cyprus and Cyrene that came to Antioch and began talking to the Greek-speaking people, declaring the Good News of the Lord Jesus. (Acts of Apostles 11:20)
- And so, talking with boldness, Paul and Barnabas said; It was necessary for the word of God to be spoken first to you. Since you are thrusting it away from you and do not judge yourselves worthy of everlasting life, look! We turn to the nations. (Acts of Apostles 13:46)
- Seated at the window, a certain young man named Eutychus fell into a deep sleep while Paul kept talking on, and, collapsing in sleep, he fell down from the third story and was picked up dead. (Acts of Apostles 20:9)
- But as they withdrew they began talking with one another, saying; This man practices nothing deserving death or bonds. (Acts of Apostles 26:31)
- I say this to our dishonor, as though our position had been weak. But if anyone else acts bold in something, I am talking unreasonably, I too am acting bold in it. (2 Corinthians 11:21)
- Neither shameful conduct nor foolish talking nor obscene jesting, things which are not becoming, but rather the giving of thanks. (Ephesians 5:4)
- At the same time they also learn to be unoccupied, gadding about to the houses, yes, not only unoccupied, but also gossipers and meddlers in other peoples affairs, talking of things they ought not. (1 Timothy 5:13)
