~TALMON (39) (Tal'mon)

- Head of a postexilic Levitical family of gatekeepers. After having returned from Babylon with Zerubbabel, he and his brothers were chosen to live in Jerusalem.
- And in Jerusalem there dwelt some of the sons of Judah and some of the sons of Benjamin and some of the sons of Ephraim and of Manasseh. (1 Chronicles 9:3)
- And the gatekeepers were Shallum and Akkub and Talmon and Ahiman and their brother Shallum the head. (1 Chronicles 9:17)
- The sons of the gatekeepers, the sons of Shallum, the sons of Ater, the sons of Talmon, the sons of Akkub, the sons of Hatita, the sons of Shobai, all together, a hundred and thirty-nine. (Ezra 2:42)
- The gatekeepers, the sons of Shallum, the sons of Ater, the sons of Talmon, the sons of Akkub, the sons of Hatita, the sons of Shobai, a hundred and thirty-eight. (Nehemiah 7:45)
- Now the princes of the people had their dwelling in Jerusalem, but as for the rest of the people, they cast lots to bring in one out of every ten to dwell in Jerusalem the holy city, and the nine other parts in the other cities. (Nehemiah 11:1)
- And the gatekeepers were Akkub, Talmon and their brothers who were keeping guard in the gates, a hundred and seventy-two.

 (Nehemiah 11:19)
- Mattaniah and Bakbukiah, Obadiah, Meshullam, Talmon, Akkub were keeping guard as gatekeepers, a guard group by the stores of the gates. (Nehemiah 12:25)
