- And there came to be born to Absalom three sons and one daughter whose name was **Tamar**. She proved to be a woman most beautiful in appearance. (2 Samuel 14:27)
- Like her father, she was very attractive in appearance. She may have married Uriel, which would have made her the mother of Rehoboam's favored wife Maacah.
- And after her he took Maacah the granddaughter of Absalom. In time she bore him Abijah and Attai and Ziza and Shelomith. (2 Chronicles 11:20)
- And Rehoboam was more in love with Maacah the granddaughter of Absalom than all his other wives and his concubines, for there were eighteen wives that he had taken, also sixty concubines, so that he became father to twenty-eight sons and sixty daughters. (2 Chronicles 11:21)
- In the eighteenth year of King Jeroboam it was that Abijah began to reign over Judah. (2 Chronicles 13:1)
- Three years he reigned in Jerusalem, and his mother's name was Micaiah the daughter of Uriel of Gibeah. And war itself took place between Abijah and Jeroboam. (2 Chronicles 13:2)
