~TAPPUAH 2 (20) (Tap'pu-ah) [Apple Tree]

- A town in the Shephelah region assigned to the tribe of Judah.
- This was the inheritance of the tribe of the sons of Judah by their families. (Joshua 15:20)
- In the Shephelah there were Eshtaol and Zorah and Ashnah. (Joshua 15:33)
- And Zanoah and En-gannim, Tappuah and Enam. (Joshua 15:34)
- It is thus distinct from Beth-tappuah in the Hebron area. Horvat Bet Natif within the abandoned village of Beit Nattif, about 20 kilometers (12 miles) West of Bethlehem, is tentatively identified as the site.
