~TEARS ## (210) [English, moan, cry, snuffle]

- Then Esau said to his father; Is there just one blessing that you have, my father? Bless me, even me too, my father! With that Esau raised his voice and burst into tears. (Genesis 27:38)
- Then Jacob kissed Rachel and raised his voice and burst into tears. (Genesis 29:11)
- And Esau went running to meet him, and he began to embrace him and fall upon his neck and kiss him, and they burst into tears. (Genesis 33:4)
- Joseph was now in a hurry, because his inward emotions were excited toward his brother, so that he looked for a place to weep and he went into an interior room and gave way to tears there. (Genesis 43:30)
- Then Joseph had his chariot made ready and went up to meet Israel his father at Goshen. When he appeared to him he at once fell upon his neck and gave way to tears upon his neck again and again. (Genesis 46:29)
- Then Joseph fell upon the face of his father and burst into tears over him and kissed him. (Genesis 50:1)
- And they took fully forty days for him, for this many days they customarily take for the embalming, and the Egyptians continued to shed tears for him seventy days. (Genesis 50:3)
- This is what you are to say to Joseph; I beseech you, pardon, please, the revolt of your brothers and their sin in that they have rendered evil to you. And now pardon, please, the revolt of the servants of your fathers God. And Joseph burst into tears when they spoke to him. (Genesis 50:17)
- Then Yehowah's spirit became operative upon him, so that he tore it in two, just as someone tears a male kid in two, and there was nothing at all in his hand. And he did not tell his father or his mother what he had done. (Judges 14:6)

- Go back, and you must say to Hezekiah the leader of my people, This is what Yehowah the God of David your forefather has said; I have heard your prayer. I have seen your tears. Here I am healing you. On the third day you will go up to the house of Yehowah. (2 Kings 20:5)
- Look! He tears down, that there may be no building up, he makes it shut to man, that it may not be opened up. (Job 12:14)
- I have grown weary with my sighing, all night long I make my couch swim, with my tears I make my own divan overflow. (Psalms 6:6)
- Do hear my prayer, O Yehowah, and to my cry for help do give ear. At my tears do not keep silent. For I am but an alien resident with you, a settler the same as all my forefathers. (Psalms 39:12)
- To me my tears have become food day and night, while they say to me all day long; Where is your God? (Psalms 42:3)
- My being a fugitive you yourself have reported. Do put my tears in your skin bottle. Are they not in your book? (Psalms 56:8)
- You have made them eat the bread of tears, and you keep making them drink tears upon tears in great measure. (Psalms 80:5)
- For you have rescued my soul from death, my eye from tears, my foot from stumbling. (Psalms 116:8)
- Those sowing seed with tears will reap even with a joyful cry. (Psalms 126:5)
- The truly wise woman has built up her house, but the foolish one tears it down with her own hands. (Proverbs 14:1)
- By justice a king makes a land keep standing, but a man out for bribes tears it down. (Proverbs 29:4)
- And I myself returned that I might see all the acts of oppression that are being done under the sun, and, look! The tears of those being oppressed, but they had no comforter, and on the side of their oppressors there was power, so that they had no comforter.

(Ecclesiastes 4:1)

- That is why I shall weep with the weeping of Jazer over the vine of Sibmah. With my tears I shall drench you, O Heshbon and Elealeh, because shouting even over your summer and over your harvest has fallen down. (Isaiah 16:9)
- He will actually swallow up death forever, and the Sovereign Lord Yehowah will certainly wipe the tears from all faces. And the reproach of his people he will take away from all the earth, for Yehowah himself has spoken it. (Isaiah 25:8)
- Go, and you must say to Hezekiah, This is what Yehowah the God of David your forefather has said; I have heard your prayer. I have seen your tears. Here I am adding onto your days fifteen years. (Isaiah 38:5)
- O that my head were waters, and that my eyes were a source of tears! Then I could weep day and night for the slain ones of the daughter of my people. (Jeremiah 9:1)
- And that they may hurry and raise up over us a lamentation. And may our eyes run down with tears and our own beaming eyes trickle with waters. (Jeremiah 9:18)
- And if you will not hear it, in places of concealment my soul will weep because of pride and will positively shed tears, and my eye will run down with tears, because the drove of Yehowah will have been carried captive. (Jeremiah 13:17)
- And you must say to them this word; Let my eyes run down with tears night and day and let them not keep still, for with a great crash the virgin daughter of my people has been broken, with an extremely sickish stroke. (Jeremiah 14:17)
- This is what Yehowah has said; Hold back your voice from weeping, and your eyes from tears, for there exists a reward for your activity, is the utterance of Yehowah, and they will certainly return from the land of the enemy. (Jeremiah 31:16)
- Profusely she weeps during the night, and her tears are upon her cheeks. She has no one to comfort her from among all her lovers. All her very own companions have dealt treacherously with her. They have become enemies to her. (Lamentations 1:2)

- My eyes have come to their end in sheer tears. My intestines are in a ferment. My liver has been poured out to the very earth, on account of the crash of the daughter of my people, because of the fainting away of child and suckling in the public squares of the town. (Lamentations 2:11)
- Their heart has cried out to Yehowah, O wall of the daughter of Zion. Cause tears to descend just like a torrent day and night. Give no numbness to yourself. May the pupil of your eye not keep quiet. (Lamentations 2:18)
- Son of man, here I am taking away from you the thing desirable to your eyes by a blow, and you should not beat your breast, neither should you weep nor should your tears come on. (Ezekiel 24:16)
- And the remaining ones of Jacob must become among the nations, in the midst of many peoples, like a lion among the beasts of a forest, like a maned young lion among droves of sheep, which, when it actually passes through, certainly both tramples down and tears in pieces, and there is no deliverer. (Micah 5:8)
- And this is the second thing that you people do, this resulting in covering with tears the altar of Yehowah, with weeping and sighing, so that there is no more a turning toward the gift offering or a taking of pleasure in anything from your hand. (Malachi 2:13)
- Further, he went on to give an illustration to them; No one cuts a patch from a new outer garment and sews it onto an old outer garment, but if he does, then both the new patch tears away and the patch from the new garment does not match the old. (Luke 5:36)
- And, taking a position behind at his feet, she wept and started to wet his feet with her tears and she would wipe them off with the hair of her head. Also, she tenderly kissed his feet and greased them with the perfumed oil. (Luke 7:38)
- With that he turned to the woman and said to Simon; Do you behold this woman? I entered into your house; You gave me no water for my feet. But this woman wet my feet with her tears

and wiped them off with her hair. (Luke 7:44)

- Jesus gave way to tears. (John 11:35)
- Slaving for the Lord with the greatest lowliness of mind and tears and trials that befell me by the plots of the Jews. (Acts of Apostles 20:19)
- Therefore keep awake, and bear in mind that for three years, night and day, I did not quit admonishing each one with tears. (Acts of Apostles 20:31)
- For out of much tribulation and anguish of heart I wrote you with many tears, not that you might be saddened, but that you might know the love that I have more especially for you. (2 Corinthians 2:4)
- Longing to see you, as I remember your tears, that I may get filled with joy. (2 Timothy 1:4)
- In the days of his flesh Christ offered up supplications and also petitions to the One who was able to save him out of death, with strong outcries and tears, and he was favorably heard for his godly fear. (Hebrews 5:7)
- For you know that afterward also when he wanted to inherit the blessing he was rejected, for, although he earnestly sought a change of mind with tears, he found no place for it. (Hebrews 12:17)
