~TELAM (28) (Te'lam)

- Twelve manuscripts of the Greek Septuagint say that Telam was one of the limits of the dwellings of the Geshurites, Girzites, and Amalekites in David's day.
- Ziph and Telem and Bealoth. (Joshua 15:24)
- This would appear to connect Telam with Telaim, referred to at;
- Accordingly Saul summoned the people and took the count of them in Telaim, two hundred thousand men on foot and ten thousand men of Judah. (1 Samuel 15:4)
- And Telem in southern Judah.
- And the cities at the extremity of the tribe of the sons of Judah toward the boundary of Edom in the south came to be Kabzeel and Eder and Jagur. (Joshua 15:21)
- Ziph and Telem and Bealoth. (Joshua 15:24)
- The Hebrew Masoretic text reads, from long ago, which differs from the expression from Telam by only two Hebrew consonants.
