

~TELAM (28) **(Te'lam)**

- Twelve manuscripts of the **Greek Septuagint** say that **Telam** was one of the limits of the dwellings of the Geshurites, Girzites, and Amalekites in David's day.
- Ziph and Telem and Bealoth. (**Joshua 15:24**)
- This would appear to connect **Telam** with Telaim, referred to at;
- Accordingly Saul summoned the people and took the count of them in **Telaim**, two hundred thousand men on foot and ten thousand men of Judah. (**1 Samuel 15:4**)
- And **Telem** in southern Judah.
- And the cities at the extremity of the tribe of the sons of Judah toward the boundary of Edom in the south came to be Kabzeel and Eder and Jagur. (**Joshua 15:21**)
- Ziph and **Telem** and Bealoth. (**Joshua 15:24**)
- The **Hebrew Masoretic** text reads, **from long ago**, which differs from the expression **from Telam** by only two **Hebrew** consonants.
