[English, One Who, lures, entices, attracts, appeals to, excites, persuades, convinces, coaxes, Opposite of, One Who, puts off]

- Satan acted as a Tempter toward Jesus to try to get him to break his integrity to God.
- Also, the Tempter came and said to him; If you are a son of God, tell these stones to become loaves of bread. (Matthew 4:3)
- Paul worried that somehow the **Tempter** might have succeeded with his Christian brothers.
- That is why, indeed, when I could bear it no longer, I sent to know of your faithfulness, as perhaps in some way the Tempter might have tempted you, and our labor might have turned out to be in vain. (1 Thessalonians 3:5)
