- Next Abraham ran to the herd and proceeded to get a tender and good young bull and to give it to the attendant, and he went hurrying to get it ready. (Genesis 18:7)

- This very one I am sending back to you, yes, him, that is, my own tender affections. (Philemon 1:12)

- Yes, brother, may I derive profit from you in connection with the Lord. Refresh my tender affections in connection with Christ. (Philemon 1:20)
- Look! We pronounce happy those who have endured. You have heard of the endurance of Job and have seen the outcome Yehowah gave, that Yehowah is very tender in affection and merciful. (James 5:11)
