## ~TERRIFIED ## (162)

[English, frightened, horrified, scared, scared stiff, pertified, shocked, alarmed]

- See, Yehowah your God has abandoned the land to you. Go up, take possession, just as Yehowah the God of your forefathers has spoken to you. Do not be afraid, nor be terrified. (Deuteronomy 1:21)
- And Yehowah is the one marching before you. He himself will continue with you. He will neither desert you nor leave you entirely. Do not be afraid or be terrified. (Deuteronomy 31:8)
- Have I not commanded you? Be courageous and strong. Do not suffer shock or be terrified, for Yehowah your God is with you wherever you go. (Joshua 1:9)
- Then Yehowah said to Joshua; Do not be afraid or be terrified. Take with you all the people of war and get up, go up to Ai. See, I have given into your hand the king of Ai and his people and his city and his land. (Joshua 8:1)
- And Joshua went on to say to them; Do not be afraid or be terrified. Be courageous and strong, for it is like this that Yehowah will do to all your enemies against whom you are warring. (Joshua 10:25)
- As for Yehowah, those contending against him will be terrified, Against them he will thunder in the heavens. Yehowah himself will judge the ends of the earth, that he may give strength to his king, that he may exalt the horn of his anointed one. (1 Samuel 2:10)
- When Saul and all Israel heard these words of the Philistine, then they became terrified and were greatly afraid. (1 Samuel 17:11)
- And their inhabitants will be feeble-handed, they will simply be terrified and will be ashamed. They must become as vegetation of the field and green tender grass, grass of the roofs, when there is a scorching before the east wind. (2 Kings 19:26)
- And David had not been able to go before it to consult God, for he

had been terrified because of the sword of Yehowah's angel. (1 Chronicles 21:30)

- In that case you will prove successful if you take care to carry out the regulations and the judicial decisions that Yehowah commanded Moses respecting Israel. Be courageous and strong. Do not be afraid nor be terrified. (1 Chronicles 22:13)
- And David went on to say to Solomon his son; Be courageous and strong and act. Do not be afraid nor be terrified, for Yehowah God, my God, is with you. He will not desert you or leave you until all the work of the service of Yehowah's house is finished. (1 Chronicles 28:20)
- Consequently he said; Pay attention, all Judah and you inhabitants of Jerusalem and King Jehoshaphat! Here is what Yehowah has said to you; Do not you be afraid or be terrified because of this large crowd, for the battle is not yours, but God's. (2 Chronicles 20:15)
- You will not need to fight in this instance. Take your position, stand still and see the salvation of Yehowah in your behalf. O Judah and Jerusalem, do not be afraid or be terrified. Tomorrow go out against them, and Yehowah will be with you. (2 Chronicles 20:17)
- Be courageous and strong. Do not be afraid nor be terrified because of the king of Assyria and on account of all the crowd that is with him, for with us there are more than there are with him. (2 Chronicles 32:7)
- Then Esther said; The man, the adversary and enemy, is this bad Haman. As for Haman, he became terrified because of the king and the queen. (Esther 7:6)
- You even have terrified me with dreams, and by visions you make me start up in fright. (Job 7:14)
- They have been terrified, they have answered no more, words have moved away from them. (Job 32:15)
- It laughs at dread, and is not terrified, nor does it turn back on account of a sword. (Job 39:22)

- And they will certainly be terrified and be ashamed of Ethiopia their looked-for hope and of Egypt their beauty. (Isaiah 20:5)
- My heart has wandered about, a shuddering itself has terrified me. The twilight for which I had an attachment has been made for me a trembling. (Isaiah 21:4)
- For this is what Yehowah has said to me; Just as the lion growls, even the maned young lion, over its prey, when there is called out against it a full number of shepherds, and in spite of their voice he will not be terrified and in spite of their commotion he will not stoop, in the same way Yehowah of armies will come down to wage war over Mount Zion and over her hill. (Isaiah 31:4)
- And his own crag will pass away out of sheer fright, and because of the signal his princes must be terrified, is the utterance of Yehowah, whose light is in Zion and whose furnace is in Jerusalem. (Isaiah 31:9)
- And their inhabitants will be feeble-handed, they will simply be terrified and ashamed. They must become as vegetation of the field and green tender grass, grass of the roofs and of the terrace before the east wind. (Isaiah 37:27)
- The wise ones have become ashamed. They have become terrified and will be caught. Look! They have rejected the very word of Yehowah, and what wisdom do they have? (Jeremiah 8:9)
- O how she has become terrified! Howl, you people! O how Moab has turned the back! He has become ashamed. And Moab has become an object of ridicule and something terrifying to all those round about him. (Jeremiah 48:39)
- Tell it among the nations and publish it. And lift up a signal, publish it. Hide nothing, O men. say; Babylon has been captured. Bel has been put to shame. Merodach has become terrified. Her images have been put to shame. Her dungy idols have become terrified. (Jeremiah 50:2)
- There is a sword against the empty talkers, and they will certainly act foolishly. There is a sword against her mighty men, and they will actually become terrified. (Jeremiah 50:36)

- So he came beside where I was standing, but when he came I got terrified so that I fell upon my face. And he proceeded to say to me; Understand, O son of man, that the vision is for the time of the end. (Daniel 8:17)
- And your mighty men must become terrified, O Teman, for the reason that each one will be cut off from the mountainous region of Esau, because of a killing. (Obadiah 1:9)
- You are going to hear of wars and reports of wars, see that you are not terrified. For these things must take place, but the end is not yet. (Matthew 24:6)
- Moreover, when you hear of wars and reports of wars, do not be terrified, these things must take place, but the end is not yet. (Mark 13:7)
- Furthermore, when you hear of wars and disorders, do not be terrified. For these things must occur first, but the end does not occur immediately. (Luke 21:9)
- But because they were terrified, and had become frightened, they were imagining they beheld a spirit. (Luke 24:37)
