## ~THADDAEUS (35) (Thad-dae'us)

- An apostle of Jesus Christ.
- The names of the twelve apostles are these, first, Simon, the one called Peter, and Andrew his brother, and James the son of Zebedee and John his brother. (Matthew 10:2)
- Philip and Bartholomew, Thomas and Matthew the tax collector, James the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus. (Matthew 10:3)
- And Andrew and Philip and Bartholomew and Matthew and Thomas and James the son of Alphaeus and Thaddaeus and Simon the Cananaean. (Mark 3:18)
- He appears to be called elsewhere Judas the son of James.
- And Judas the son of James, and Judas Iscariot, who turned traitor. (Luke 6:16)
- Judas, not Iscariot, said to him; Lord, what has happened that you intend to show yourself plainly to us and not to the world? (John 14:22)
- So, when they had entered, they went up into the upper chamber, where they were staying, Peter as well as John and James and Andrew, Philip and Thomas, Bartholomew and Matthew, James the son of Alphaeus and Simon the zealous one, and Judas the son of James. (Acts of Apostles 1:13)
