~THANKSGIVING ## (164) [English, blessing, prayer, thanks]

- If he would present it in expression of thanksgiving, then he must present along with the sacrifice of thanksgiving unfermented ring-shaped cakes moistened with oil and unfermented wafers smeared with oil and well-mixed fine flour as ring-shaped cakes moistened with oil. (Leviticus 7:12)
- Along with ring-shaped cakes of leavened bread he will present his offering together with the thanksgiving sacrifice of his communion sacrifices. (Leviticus 7:13)
- And the flesh of the thanksgiving sacrifice of his communion sacrifices is to be eaten on the day of his offering. He must not save up any of it until morning. (Leviticus 7:15)
- And in case you should sacrifice a thanksgiving sacrifice to Yehowah, you should sacrifice it to gain approval for you. (Leviticus 22:29)
- Finally Hezekiah answered and said; Now you have filled your hand with power for Yehowah. Approach, and bring sacrifices and thanksgiving sacrifices to the house of Yehowah. And the congregation began to bring sacrifices and thanksgiving sacrifices, and also every one willing of heart, burnt offerings. (2 Chronicles 29:31)
- Moreover, he prepared the altar of Yehowah and began to sacrifice upon it communion sacrifices and thanksgiving sacrifices and went on to say to Judah to serve Yehowah the God of Israel. (2 Chronicles 33:16)
- Then I brought up the princes of Judah upon the wall. Further, I appointed two large thanksgiving choirs and processions, and the one was walking to the right upon the wall to the Gate of the Ash-heaps. (Nehemiah 12:31)
- And the other thanksgiving choir was walking in front, and I after it, also half of the people, upon the wall up over the Tower of the Bake Ovens and on to the Broad Wall. (Nehemiah 12:38)

- At length the two thanksgiving choirs came to a stand at the house of the true God, also I and half of the deputy rulers with me. (Nehemiah 12:40)
- To cause thanksgiving to be heard aloud, and to declare all your wonderful works. (Psalms 26:7)
- These things I will remember, and I will pour out my soul within me. For I used to pass along with the throng, I used to walk slowly before them to the house of God, with the voice of a joyful cry and thanksgiving, of a crowd celebrating a festival. (Psalms 42:4)
- Offer thanksgiving as your sacrifice to God, and pay to the Most High your vows. (Psalms 50:14)
- The one offering thanksgiving as his sacrifice is the one that glorifies me, and as for the one keeping a set way, I will cause him to see salvation by God. (Psalms 50:23)
- Upon me, O God, there are vows to you. I shall render expressions of thanksgiving to you. (Psalms 56:12)
- I will praise the name of God with song, and I will magnify him with thanksgiving. (Psalms 69:30)
- Let us come before his person with thanksgiving, let us with melodies shout in triumph to him. (Psalms 95:2)
- Exalt Yehowah our God and bow down yourselves at his holy mountain. For Yehowah our God is holy. A melody of thanksgiving. (Psalms 99:9)
- Come into his gates with thanksgiving, into his courtyards with praise. Give thanks to him, bless his name. (Psalms 100:4)
- And let them offer the sacrifices of thanksgiving and declare his works with a joyful cry. (Psalms 107:22)
- To you I shall offer the sacrifice of thanksgiving, and on the name of Yehowah I shall call. (Psalms 116:17)
- Respond to Yehowah with thanksgiving, you people, make melody to our God on the harp. (Psalms 147:7)

- For Yehowah will certainly comfort Zion. He will for certain comfort all her devastated places, and he will make her wilderness like Eden and her desert plain like the garden of Yehowah. Exultation and rejoicing themselves will be found in her, thanksgiving and the voice of melody. (Isaiah 51:3)
- And people will actually come from the cities of Judah and from round about Jerusalem and from the land of Benjamin and from the lowland and from the mountainous region and from the Negeb, bringing whole burnt offering and sacrifice and grain offering and frankincense and bringing thanksgiving sacrifice into the house of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 17:26)
- And from them there will certainly go forth thanksgiving, and the sound of those who are laughing. And I will multiply them, and they will not become few, and I will make them heavy in number, and they will not become insignificant. (Jeremiah 30:19)
- The sound of exultation and the sound of rejoicing, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the voice of those saying; Laud Yehowah of armies, for Yehowah is good, for to time indefinite is his loving-kindness! They will be bringing a thanksgiving offering into the house of Yehowah, for I shall bring back the captives of the land just as at the start, Yehowah has said. (Jeremiah 33:11)
- And from what is leavened make a thanksgiving sacrifice to smoke, and proclaim voluntary offerings, publish it, for that is the way you have loved, O sons of Israel, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Amos 4:5)
- But as for me, with the voice of thanksgiving I will sacrifice to you. What I have vowed, I will pay. Salvation belongs to Yehowah. (Jonah 2:9)
- For all things are for your sakes, in order, that the undeserved kindness which was multiplied should abound because of the thanksgiving of many more to the glory of God. (2 Corinthians 4:15)
- Do not be anxious over anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication along with thanksgiving let your petitions be made known to God. (Philippians 4:6)

- Rooted and being built up in him and being stabilized in the faith, just as you were taught, overflowing with faith in thanksgiving. (Colossians 2:7)
- Be persevering in prayer, remaining awake in it with thanksgiving. (Colossians 4:2)
- For what thanksgiving can we render to God concerning you in return for all the joy with which we are rejoicing on your account before our God. (1 Thessalonians 3:9)
- Forbidding to marry, commanding to abstain from foods which God created to be partaken of with thanksgiving by those who have faith and accurately know the truth. (1 Timothy 4:3)
- The reason for this is that every creation of God is fine, and nothing is to be rejected if it is received with thanksgiving. (1 Timothy 4:4)
- And whenever the living creatures offer glory and honor and thanksgiving to the one seated upon the throne, the one that lives forever and ever. (Revelation 4:9)
- Saying; Amen! The blessing and the glory and the wisdom and the thanksgiving and the honor and the power and the strength be to our God forever and ever. Amen. (Revelation 7:12)
