- That is why I shall thank you, O Yehowah, among the nations, and to your name I shall make melody. (2 Samuel 22:50)
- Then he put before the ark of Yehowah some of the Levites as ministers, both to call to remembrance and to thank and praise Yehowah the God of Israel. (1 Chronicles 16:4)
- It was then on that day that David made a contribution for the first time to thank Yehowah by means of Asaph and his brothers. (1 Chronicles 16:7)
