~TIPHSAH 2 (17) (Tiph'sah)

- A place, apparently in the vicinity of Tirzah, that was struck down by Israel's King Menahem circa 790-781 B.C.E.
- It was then that Menahem proceeded to strike down Tiphsah and all that was in it and its territory out from Tirzah, because it did not open up, and he went striking it down. All its pregnant women he ripped up. (2 Kings 15:16)
- Its exact location is not known. Khirbet Tafsah, about 10 kilometers (6 miles) West-Southwest of ancient Shechem, bears a similar name but appears to be too far from the assumed site of Tirzah to be the location of this Tiphsah.
