[English, exhausting, strenuous, arduous, wearing, demanding, laborious]

- The soul of the people began tiring out from the long trek to go around the land of Edom.
- While they continued trekking from Mount Hor by the way of the Red Sea to go around the land of Edom, the soul of the people began tiring out because of the way. (Numbers 21:4)
- Jeremiah compares his people going after Baal to a zebra at her time for copulation. She will certainly find a mate, and those looking for her will not be tiring themselves out looking for her.
- A zebra accustomed to the wilderness, at the craving of her soul, snuffing up the wind, at her time for copulation, who can turn her back? All those who are looking for her will not go tiring themselves out. In her month they will find her. (Jeremiah 2:24)
