~TOB-ADONIJAH (26) (Tob-ad-o-ni'jah) [Good Is the Lord Yah]

- One of the Levites whom Jehoshaphat, in the third year of his reign, sent out to teach Yehowah's Law in the cities of Judah.
- And in the third year of his reigning he sent for his princes, namely, Ben-hail and Obadiah and Zechariah and Nethanel and Micaiah, to teach in the cities of Judah. (2 Chronicles 17:7)
- And with them the Levites, Shemaiah and Nethaniah and Zebadiah and Asahel and Shemiramoth and Jehonathan and Adonijah and Tobijah and Tob-Adonijah the Levites, and with them Elishama and Jehoram the priests. (2 Chronicles 17:8)
- And they began teaching in Judah, and with them there was the book of Yehowah's law, and they kept going around through all the cities of Judah and teaching among the people. (2 Chronicles 17:9)
- Reference to Adonijah and Tobijah in the same verse leads some scholars to believe this name is a scribal dittograph, that is, an inadvertent repetition.
