~TOI (39) (To'i), Tou (To'u)

- King of Hamath. On learning that David had defeated their mutual enemy Hadadezer the king of Zobah, Toi immediately sent his son with congratulations and gifts. These David sanctified along with his battle spoil.
- And the sons of Samuel were the firstborn Joel and the second Abijah. (1 Chronicles 6:28)
- The sons of Merari were Mahli, Libni his son, Shimei his son, Uzzah his son. (1 Chronicles 6:29)
- Shimea his son, Haggiah his son, Asaiah his son. (1 Chronicles 6:30)
- And these were the ones to whom David gave positions for the direction of the singing at the house of Yehowah after the Ark had a resting-place. (1 Chronicles 6:31)
- When Tou the king of Hamath heard that David had struck down all the military force of Hadadezer the king of Zobah. (1 Chronicles 18:9)
- He immediately sent Hadoram his son to King David to ask him about his welfare and congratulate him over the fact that he had fought against Hadadezer so that he struck him down, for Hadadezer had become trained in warfare against Tou, and there were with him all sorts of articles of gold and silver and copper. (1 Chronicles 18:10)
- These also King David sanctified to Yehowah together with the silver and the gold that he had carried off from all the nations, from Edom and from Moab and from the sons of Ammon and from the Philistines and from Amalek. (1 Chronicles 18:11)
