~TOLA 1 (39) (To'la) [Crimson or Scarlet Cloth]

- First-named son of Issachar who accompanied Jacob's household into Egypt in 1728 B.C.E.
- Now these are the names of Israel's sons who came into Egypt; Jacob and his sons, Jacob's firstborn was Reuben. (Genesis 46:8)
- And the sons of Issachar were Tola and Puvah and Iob and Shimron. (Genesis 46:13)
- Tolas sons and some of his grandsons founded populous tribal families in Issachar, collectively known as Tolaites.
- The sons of Issachar by their families were, of Tola the family of the Tolaites. Of Puvah the family of the Punites. (Numbers 26:23)
- Now the sons of Issachar were Tola and Puah, Jashub and Shimron, four. (1 Chronicles 7:1)
- And the sons of Tola were Uzzi and Rephaiah and Jeriel and Jahmai and Ibsam and Shemuel, heads of the house of their forefathers. Of Tola there were valiant, mighty men, by their descendants. Their number in the days of David was twenty-two thousand six hundred. (1 Chronicles 7:2)
- And the sons of Uzzi were Izrahiah, and the sons of Izrahiah were Michael and Obadiah and Joel, Isshiah, five, all of them being heads. (1 Chronicles 7:3)
- And with them by their descendants, according to the house of their forefathers, there were troops of the army for war, thirty-six thousand, for they had many wives and sons. (1 Chronicles 7:4)
