

~TOUCHING ## (136)

[English, moving, poignant, stirring, tender, pitiful, emotive, sad, heartbreaking, heartrending, affecting]

- Then Abimelech commanded all the people, saying; Anybody **touching** this man and his wife will surely be put to death! (Genesis 26:11)
- And you must set bounds for the people round about, saying; Guard yourselves against going up into the mountain, and do not touch the edge of it. Anybody **touching** the mountain will positively be put to death. (Exodus 19:12)
- And you must sanctify them that they may indeed become most holy. Anyone **touching** them is to be holy. (Exodus 30:29)
- So by these you would make yourselves unclean. Everyone **touching** their dead bodies will be unclean until the evening. (Leviticus 11:24)
- As for any beast that is a splitter of the hoof but is not a former of a cleft and is not a chewer of the cud, they are unclean for you. Everyone **touching** them will be unclean. (Leviticus 11:26)
- As for every creature going upon its paws among all the living creatures that go on all fours, they are unclean to you. Everyone **touching** their dead bodies will be unclean until the evening. (Leviticus 11:27)
- These are unclean to you among all the swarming creatures. Everyone **touching** them in their death state will be unclean until the evening. (Leviticus 11:31)
- Only a spring and a pit of impounded waters will continue clean, but anyone **touching** their dead bodies will be unclean. (Leviticus 11:36)
- And anyone **touching** anything that happens to be under him will be unclean until the evening, and he who carries them will wash his garments, and he must bathe in water and be unclean until the evening. (Leviticus 15:10)

- And in case a woman is having a running discharge, and her running discharge in her flesh proves to be blood, she should continue seven days in her menstrual impurity, and anyone **touching** her will be unclean until the evening. (**Leviticus 15:19**)
- And anyone **touching** her bed should wash his garments, and he must bathe in water and be unclean until the evening. (**Leviticus 15:21**)
- And anyone **touching** any article upon which she was sitting should wash his garments, and he must bathe in water and be unclean until the evening. (**Leviticus 15:22**)
- And if it was upon the bed or upon another article that she was sitting, by his **touching** it he will be unclean until the evening. (**Leviticus 15:23**)
- And anyone **touching** them will be unclean, and he must wash his garments and bathe in water and be unclean until the evening. (**Leviticus 15:27**)
- Anyone **touching** the corpse of any human soul must also be unclean seven days. (**Numbers 19:11**)
- Everyone **touching** a corpse, the soul of whatever man may die, and who will not purify himself, has defiled Yehowah's tabernacle, and that soul must be cut off from Israel. Because the water for cleansing has not been sprinkled upon him, he continues unclean. His uncleanness is still upon him. (**Numbers 19:13**)
- And it must serve as a statute to time indefinite for them, that the one spattering the water for cleansing should wash his garments, also the one **touching** the water for cleansing. He will be unclean until the evening. (**Numbers 19:21**)
- Finally he lay down and fell asleep under the broom tree. But, look! Now an angel was **touching** him. Then he said to him; Rise up, eat. (**1 Kings 19:5**)
- Likewise with anyone having relations with the wife of his fellowman, no one **touching** her will remain unpunishable. (**Proverbs 6:29**)

- This is what Yehowah has said against all my bad neighbors, who are **touching** the hereditary possession that I caused my people, even Israel, to possess; Here I am uprooting them from off their ground, and the house of Judah I shall uproot from the midst of them. (**Jeremiah 12:14**)
- And there was the sound of the wings of the living creatures that were closely **touching** each other, and the sound of the wheels close beside them, and the sound of a great rushing. (**Ezekiel 3:13**)
- And I, for my part, kept on considering, and, look! There was a male of the goats coming from the sunset upon the surface of the whole earth, and it was not **touching** the earth. And as regards the he-goat, there was a conspicuous horn between its eyes. (**Daniel 8:5**)
- And, look! One similar to the likeness of the sons of mankind was **touching** my lips, and I began to open my mouth and speak and say to the one who was standing in front of me; O my lord, because of the appearance my convulsions were turned within me, and I did not retain any power. (**Daniel 10:16**)
- And the Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of the armies, is the One **touching** the land, so that it melts, and all the inhabitants in it will have to mourn, and it will certainly come up like the Nile, all of it, and sink down like the Nile of Egypt. (**Amos 9:5**)
- For this is what Yehowah of armies has said; Following after the glory he has sent me to the nations that were despoiling you people, for he that is **touching** you is touching my eyeball. (**Zechariah 2:8**)
- Then Jesus came near and, **touching** them, said; Get up and have no fear. (**Matthew 17:7**)
- At the sight the Pharisee that invited him said within himself; This man, if he were a prophet, would know who and what kind of woman it is that is **touching** him, that she is a sinner. (**Luke 7:39**)
- Therefore get out from among them, and separate yourselves, says Yehowah, and quit **touching** the unclean thing, and I will take you in. (**2 Corinthians 6:17**)
