- I have seen those who are treacherous in dealing, and I do feel a loathing, because they have not kept your own saying; (Psalms 119:158)
- As regards the wicked, they will be cut off from the very earth, and as for the treacherous, they will be torn away from it. (Proverbs 2:22)
- The eyes of Yehowah himself have safeguarded knowledge, but he subverts the words of the treacherous one. (Proverbs 22:12)
- Surely she, just like a robber, lies in wait, and among men she increases the treacherous ones. (Proverbs 23:28)
