## ~TREASURE ## (130)

[English, money, riches, wealth, fortune, jewels, gold, silver, hoard, booty, plunder]

- Then he said; It is all right with you. Do not be afraid. Your God and the God of your father gave you treasure in your bags. Your money came first to me. After that he brought out Simeon to them. (Genesis 43:23)
- But all the silver and the gold and the articles of copper and iron are something holy to Yehowah. Into the treasure of Yehowah it should go. (Joshua 6:19)
- And they burned the city with fire and everything that was in it. Only the silver and the gold and the articles of copper and iron they gave to the treasure of Yehowah's house. (Joshua 6:24)
- And what stones were found with any persons they gave to the treasure of the house of Yehowah under the control of Jehiel the Gershonite. (1 Chronicles 29:8)
- And there was a part of the heads of the paternal houses that gave to the work. The Tirshatha himself gave to the treasure a thousand gold drachmas, fifty bowls, five hundred and thirty priests robes. (Nehemiah 7:70)
- And there were some of the heads of the paternal houses that gave to the treasure for the work twenty thousand gold drachmas and two thousand two hundred silver minas.

  (Nehemiah 7:71)
- From men, by your hand, O Yehowah, from men of this system of things, whose share is in this life, and whose belly you fill with your concealed treasure, who are satisfied with sons and who do lay up for their children what they leave over. (Psalms 17:14)
- My son, if you will receive my sayings and treasure up my own commandments with yourself. (Proverbs 2:1)
- And for the upright ones he will treasure up practical wisdom, for those walking in integrity he is a shield. (Proverbs 2:7)

- My son, keep my sayings, and may you treasure up my own commandments with you. (Proverbs 7:1)
- The wise are the ones that treasure up knowledge, but the mouth of the foolish one is near to ruin itself. (Proverbs 10:14)
- Desirable treasure and oil are in the abode of the wise one, but the man that is stupid will swallow it up. (Proverbs 21:20)
- For treasure will not be to time indefinite, nor a diadem for all generations. (Proverbs 27:24)
- And the trustworthiness of your times must prove to be a wealth of salvations, wisdom and knowledge, the fear of Yehowah, which is his treasure. (Isaiah 33:6)
- There is a conspiracy of her prophets in the midst of her, like the roaring lion, tearing prey. A soul they actually devour. Treasure and precious things they keep taking. Her widows they have multiplied in the midst of her. (Ezekiel 22:25)
- In case he himself as the son of reed plants should show fruitfulness, an east wind, the wind of Yehowah, will come. From a wilderness it is coming up, and it will dry up his well and drain his spring. That one will pillage the treasure of all desirable articles. (Hosea 13:15)
- For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. (Matthew 6:21)
- The good man out of his good treasure sends out good things, whereas the wicked man out of his wicked treasure sends out wicked things. (Matthew 12:35)
- The kingdom of the heavens is like a treasure hidden in the field, which a man found and hid, and for the joy he has he goes and sells what things he has and buys that field. (Matthew 13:44)
- Then he said to them; That being the case, every public instructor, when taught respecting the kingdom of the heavens, is like a man, a householder, who brings out of his treasure store things new and old. (Matthew 13:52)
- Jesus said to him; If you want to be perfect, go sell your

belongings and give to the poor and you will have treasure in heaven, and come be my follower. (Matthew 19:21)

- Jesus looked upon him and felt love for him and said to him; One thing is missing about you. Go, sell what things you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven, and come be my follower. (Mark 10:21)
- A good man brings forth good out of the good treasure of his heart, but a wicked man brings forth what is wicked out of his wicked treasure, for out of the hearts abundance his mouth speaks. (Luke 6:45)
- So it goes with the man that lays up treasure for himself but is not rich toward God. (Luke 12:21)
- Sell the things belonging to you and give gifts of mercy. Make purses for yourselves that do not wear out, a never-failing treasure in the heavens, where a thief does not get near nor moth consumes. (Luke 12:33)
- For where your treasure is, there your hearts will be also. (Luke 12:34)
- After hearing that, Jesus said to him; There is yet one thing lacking about you. Sell all the things you have and distribute to poor people, and you will have treasure in the heavens, and come be my follower. (Luke 18:22)
- With that he rose and went, and, look! An Ethiopian eunuch, a man in power under Candace queen of the Ethiopians, and who was over all her treasure. He had gone to Jerusalem to worship. (Acts of Apostles 8:27)
- However, we have this **treasure** in earthen vessels, that the power beyond what is normal may be God's and not that out of ourselves. (2 Corinthians 4:7)
