- And by me an order has been put through as to what you will do with these older men of the Jews, for rebuilding that house of God, and from the royal treasury of the tax beyond the River the expense will promptly be given to these able-bodied men without cessation. (Ezra 6:8)
- If to the king it does seem good, let there be a writing that they be destroyed, and ten thousand silver talents I shall pay into the hands of those doing the work by bringing it into the kings treasury. (Esther 3:9)
- Then Mordecai told him about all the things that had befallen him and the exact statement of the money that Haman had said to pay to the kings treasury against the Jews, to destroy them. (Esther 4:7)
- Accordingly Ebed-melech took the men in his charge and went into the house of the king to beneath the treasury and took from there worn-out rags and worn-out pieces of cloth and let them down to Jeremiah into the cistern by means of the ropes.

 (Jeremiah 38:11)
- At that, Yehowah said to me; Throw it to the treasury, the majestic value with which I have been valued from their standpoint. Accordingly I took the thirty pieces of silver and threw it into the treasury at the house of Yehowah. (Zechariah 11:13)
- But the chief priests took the silver pieces and said; It is not lawful to drop them into the sacred treasury, because they are the price of blood. (Matthew 27:6)
- And he sat down with the treasury chests in view and began observing how the crowd was dropping money into the treasury chests, and many rich people were dropping in many coins. (Mark 12:41)
- So he called his disciples to him and said to them; Truly I say to you that this poor widow dropped in more than all those

dropping money into the treasury chests. (Mark 12:43)

- Now as he looked up he saw the rich dropping their gifts into the treasury chests. (Luke 21:1)
- These sayings he spoke in the treasury as he was teaching in the temple. But no one laid hold of him, because his hour had not yet come. (John 8:20)
