- O daughter of Babylon, who are to be despoiled, happy will he be that rewards you with your own treatment with which you treated us. (Psalms 137:8)
- He that is showing favor to the lowly one is lending to Yehowah, and his treatment He will repay to him. (Proverbs 19:17)
- Woe to the wicked one! Calamity! For the treatment rendered by his own hands will be rendered to him! (Isaiah 3:11)
