- And Isaac began to shake with a great trembling in extreme measure, and so he said; Who, then, was it that hunted for game and came bringing it to me, so that I ate of everything before you could come in and I blessed him? Blessed too he will become! (Genesis 27:33)
- At that he said to his brothers; My money has been returned and now here it is in my bag! Then their hearts sank, so that they turned trembling to one another, saying; What is this God has done to us? (Genesis 42:28)
- At that time the sheiks of Edom will indeed be disturbed. As for the despots of Moab, trembling will take hold on them. All the inhabitants of Canaan will indeed be disheartened. (Exodus 15:15)
- And Mount Sinai smoked all over, due to the fact that Yehowah came down upon it in fire, and its smoke kept ascending like the smoke of a kiln, and the whole mountain was trembling very much. (Exodus 19:18)
- And among those nations you will have no ease, nor will there prove to be any resting-place for the sole of your foot, and Yehowah will indeed give you there a trembling heart and a failing of the eyes and despair of soul. (Deuteronomy 28:65)
- And now call out, please, in the hearing of the people, saying; Who is there afraid and trembling? Let him retire. So Gideon put them to the proof. With that, twenty-two thousand of the people retired, and there were ten thousand that remained. (Judges 7:3)
- When Zebah and Zalmunna took to flight, he at once went in pursuit of them and got to capture Midian's two kings, Zebah and Zalmunna, and he drove all the camp into trembling. (Judges 8:12)
- Then a trembling occurred in the camp in the field and among all the people of the outpost, and the force of pillagers trembled,

- even they, and the earth began quaking, and it developed into a trembling from God. (1 Samuel 14:15)
- And I shall come upon him when he is weary and feeble in both hands, and I shall certainly drive him into trembling, and all the people that are with him will have to flee, and I shall certainly strike down the king by himself. (2 Samuel 17:2)
- Also to me they came gathering themselves, everyone trembling because of the words of the God of Israel against the unfaithfulness of the exiled people, while I was sitting stunned until the grain offering of the evening. (Ezra 9:4)
- And now let us conclude a covenant with our God to put away all the wives and those born from them according to the counsel of Yehowah and of those trembling at the commandment of our God, that it may be done according to the Law. (Ezra 10:3)
- A dread came over me, and a trembling, and the multitude of my bones it filled with dread. (Job 4:14)
- Those impotent in death keep trembling beneath the waters and those residing in them. (Job 26:5)
- Serve Yehowah with fear and be joyful with trembling. (Psalms 2:11)
- To judge the fatherless boy and the crushed one, that mortal man who is of the earth may no more cause trembling. (Psalms 10:18)
- Trembling itself took hold of them there, birth pangs like those of a woman giving birth. (Psalms 48:6)
- Fear, yes, trembling itself enters into me, and shuddering covers me. (Psalms 55:5)
- Trembling at men is what lays a snare, but he that is trusting in Yehowah will be protected. (Proverbs 29:25)
- My heart has wandered about, a shuddering itself has terrified me. The twilight for which I had an attachment has been made for me a trembling. (Isaiah 21:4)

- The islands saw and began to fear. The very extremities of the earth began trembling. They drew near and kept coming. (Isaiah 41:5)
- Now all these things my own hand has made, so that all these came to be, is the utterance of Yehowah. To this one, then, I shall look, to the one afflicted and contrite in spirit and trembling at my word. (Isaiah 66:2)
- Hear the word of Yehowah, you men who are trembling at his word; Your brothers that are hating you, that are excluding you by reason of my name, said; May Yehowah be glorified! He must also appear with rejoicing on your part, and they are the ones that will be put to shame. (Isaiah 66:5)
- For this is what Yehowah has said; The sound of trembling we have heard, dread, and there is no peace. (Jeremiah 30:5)
- And as for you, do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, is the utterance of Yehowah, and do not be struck with terror, O Israel. For here I am saving you from far off and your offspring from the land of their captivity. And Jacob will certainly return and be free of disturbance and be at ease, and there will be no one causing trembling. (Jeremiah 30:10)
- And as for you, do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, and do not be terror-stricken, O Israel. For here I am saving you from far away and your offspring from the land of their captivity. And Jacob will certainly return and have no disturbance and be at ease and without anyone causing trembling. (Jeremiah 46:27)
- And down from their thrones all the chieftains of the sea will certainly come and remove their sleeveless coats, and they will strip off their own embroidered garments. They will put on trembling spells. Upon the earth they will sit down, and they will certainly tremble every moment and stare in amazement at you. (Ezekiel 26:16)
- In that day messengers will go forth from before me in the ships, in order to drive self-confident Ethiopia into trembling. And severe pains must occur among them in the day of Egypt, for, look! it must come. (Ezekiel 30:9)
- And I saw, I Daniel by myself, the appearance, but as for the men

that happened to be with me, they did not see the appearance. However, there was a great trembling that fell upon them, so that they went running away in hiding themselves. (Daniel 10:7)

- After Yehowah they will walk. Like a lion he will roar, for he himself will roar, and sons will come trembling from the west. (Hosea 11:10)
- Like a bird they will come trembling out of Egypt, and like a dove out of the land of Assyria, and I shall certainly make them dwell in their houses, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Hosea 11:11)
- When Ephraim spoke, there was trembling, he himself carried weight in Israel. But he proceeded to become guilty in regard to Baal and die. (Hosea 13:1)
- At that I said; What are these coming to do? And he went on to say; These are the horns that dispersed Judah to such an extent that no one at all raised his head, and these others will come to set them trembling, to cast down the horns of the nations that are lifting up a horn against the land of Judah, in order to disperse her. (Zechariah 1:21)
- But the woman, frightened and trembling, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell down before him and told him the whole truth. (Mark 5:33)
- So when they came out they fled from the memorial tomb, for trembling and strong emotion were gripping them. And they told nobody anything, for they were in fear. (Mark 16:8)
- Seeing that she had not escaped notice, the woman came trembling and fell down before him and disclosed before all the people the cause for which she touched him and how she was healed instantly. (Luke 8:47)
- I am the God of your forefathers, the God of Abraham and of Isaac and of Jacob. Seized with trembling, Moses did not dare to investigate further. (Acts of Apostles 7:32)
- So he asked for lights and leaped in and, seized with trembling, he fell down before Paul and Silas. (Acts of Apostles 16:29)
- And I came to you in weakness and in fear and with much

trembling. (1 Corinthians 2:3)

- Also, his tender affections are more abundant toward you, while he calls to mind the obedience of all of you, how you received him with fear and trembling. (2 Corinthians 7:15)
- You slaves, be obedient to those who are your masters in a fleshly sense, with fear and trembling in the sincerity of your hearts, as to the Christ. (Ephesians 6:5)
- Consequently, my beloved ones, in the way that you have always obeyed, not during my presence only, but now much more readily during my absence, keep working out your own salvation with fear and trembling. (Philippians 2:12)
- Also, the display was so fearsome that Moses said; I am fearful and trembling. (Hebrews 12:21)
