- However, the sons of Benjamin imagined that the men of Israel faced defeat when they kept giving ground to Benjamin because they trusted in the ambush that they had set against Gibeah. (Judges 20:36)
- In Yehowah the God of Israel he trusted, and after him there proved to be no one like him among all the kings of Judah, even those who had happened to be prior to him. (2 Kings 18:5)
- Accordingly Rabshakeh said to them; Please, say to Hezekiah, This is what the great king, the king of Assyria, has said; What is this confidence in which you have trusted? (2 Kings 18:19)
- And they came to be helped against them, so that the Hagrites and all those who were with them were given into their hand, for it was to God that they called for aid in the war, and he let himself be entreated in their favor because they trusted in him. (1 Chronicles 5:20)
- They certainly are ashamed because they had trusted, they have come clear to the place and they get disappointed. (Job 6:20)
- As for me, in your loving-kindness I have trusted, let my heart be joyful in your salvation. (Psalms 13:5)
- In you our fathers trusted, they trusted, and you kept providing them with escape. (Psalms 22:4)
- To you they cried out, and they got away safe, in you they trusted, and they did not come to shame. (Psalms 22:5)
- Judge me, O Yehowah, for I myself have walked in my own integrity, and in Yehowah I have trusted, that I may not wobble. (Psalms 26:1)
- Yehowah is my strength and my shield. In him my heart has trusted, and I have been helped, so that my heart exults, and with my song I shall laud him. (Psalms 28:7)

- Also the man at peace with me, in whom I trusted, who was eating my bread, has magnified his heel against me. (Psalms 41:9)
- That I may answer the one reproaching me with a word, for I have trusted in your word. (Psalms 119:42)
- Accordingly Rabshakeh said to them; Please, say to Hezekiah, This is what the great king, the king of Assyria, has said; What is this confidence in which you have trusted? (Isaiah 36:4)
- Look! You have trusted in the support of this crushed reed, in Egypt, which, if a man should brace himself upon it, would certainly enter into his palm and pierce it. That is the way Pharaoh the king of Egypt is to all those putting their trust in him. (Isaiah 36:6)
- For I shall without fail furnish you an escape, and by the sword you will not fall, and you will certainly come to have your soul as a spoil, because you have trusted in me, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 39:18)
- Nebuchadnezzar was answering and saying; Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, who sent his angel and rescued his servants that trusted in him and that changed the very word of the king and gave over their bodies, because they would not serve and would not worship any god at all except their own God. (Daniel 3:28)
- Then it was that the king himself became very glad, and Daniel himself he commanded to be lifted up out of the pit. And Daniel was lifted up out of the pit, and there was no hurt at all found on him, because he had trusted in his God. (Daniel 6:23)
- You people have plowed wickedness. Unrighteousness is what you have reaped. You have eaten the fruitage of deception, for you have trusted in your way, in the multitude of your mighty ones. (Hosea 10:13)
- Of what benefit has a carved image been, when the former of it has carved it, a molten statue, and an instructor in falsehood? when the former of its form has trusted in it, to the extent of making valueless gods that are speechless? (Habakkuk 2:18)

But he spoke this illustration also to some who trusted in themselves that they were righteous and who considered the rest as nothing. (Luke 18:9)
