- Consequently the Egyptians made the sons of Israel slave under tyranny. (Exodus 1:13)
- And they kept making their life bitter with hard slavery at clay mortar and bricks and with every form of slavery in the field, yes, every form of slavery of theirs in which they used them as slaves under tyranny. (Exodus 1:14)
- You must not tread down upon him with tyranny, and you must be in fear of your God. (Leviticus 25:43)
- And you must pass them on as an inheritance to your sons after you to inherit as a possession to time indefinite. You may use them as workers, but upon your brothers the sons of Israel, you must not tread, the one upon the other, with tyranny. (Leviticus 25:46)
- He should continue with him like a hired laborer from year to year. He may not tread him down with tyranny before your eyes. (Leviticus 25:53)
- The sickened ones you have not strengthened, and the ailing one you have not healed, and the broken one you have not bandaged, and the dispersed one you have not brought back, and the lost one you have not sought to find, but with harshness you have had them in subjection, even with tyranny. (Ezekiel 34:4)
