- Or in case he touches the uncleanness of a man as respects any uncleanness of his with which he may become unclean, although it had been hidden from him, and yet he himself has come to know it, then he has become guilty. (Leviticus 5:3)
- And the soul who eats the flesh of the communion sacrifice, which is for Yehowah, while his uncleanness is upon him, that soul must be cut off from his people. (Leviticus 7:20)
- And in case a soul touches anything unclean, the uncleanness of a man or an unclean beast or any unclean loathsome thing, and actually eats some of the flesh of the communion sacrifice, which is for Yehowah, that soul must be cut off from his people. (Leviticus 7:21)
- And this will become his uncleanness by his discharge. Whether his genital organ has flowed with a running discharge or his genital organ is obstructed from his running discharge, it is his uncleanness. (Leviticus 15:3)
- Any bed upon which she may lie any of the days of her running discharge will become for her as the bed of her menstrual impurity, and any article upon which she may sit will become unclean like the uncleanness of her menstrual impurity. (Leviticus 15:26)
- And you must keep the sons of Israel separate from their uncleanness, that they may not die in their uncleanness for their defiling of my tabernacle, which is in their midst. (Leviticus 15:31)
- And the menstruating woman in her uncleanness, and anyone who has a flow of his running discharge, whether a male or a female, and whether a man who lies down with an unclean woman. (Leviticus 15:33)
- Say to them; Throughout your generations any man of all your offspring who comes near to the holy things, which the sons of

Israel will sanctify to Yehowah, while his uncleanness is upon him, that soul must be cut off from before me. I am Yehowah. (Leviticus 22:3)

- Nor a man who touches any swarming thing that is unclean for him or touches a man who is unclean for him as respects any uncleanness of his. (Leviticus 22:5)
- And the priest must make her swear, and he must say to the woman; If no man has lain down with you and if while under your husband you have not turned aside in any uncleanness, be free of the effect of this bitter water that brings a curse. (Numbers 5:19)
- Everyone touching a corpse, the soul of whatever man may die, and who will not purify himself, has defiled Yehowah's tabernacle, and that soul must be cut off from Israel. Because the water for cleansing has not been sprinkled upon him, he continues unclean. His uncleanness is still upon him. (Numbers 19:13)
- After that David sent messengers that he might take her. So she came in to him and he lay down with her, while she was sanctifying herself from her uncleanness. Later she returned to her house. (2 Samuel 11:4)
- The priests now came inside the house of Yehowah to do the cleansing and brought out all the uncleanness that they found in the temple of Yehowah to the courtyard of the house of Yehowah. In turn the Levites received it to take it out to the torrent valley of Kidron outside. (2 Chronicles 29:16)
- Then the sons of Israel that had returned from the Exile ate, and everyone that had separated himself to them from the uncleanness of the nations of the land, to search for Yehowah the God of Israel. (Ezra 6:21)
- Which you commanded by means of your servants the prophets, saying; The land that you people are going in to take possession of is an impure land because of the impurity of the peoples of the lands, because of their detestable things with which they have filled it from end to end by their uncleanness. (Ezra 9:11)
- Her uncleanness is in her skirts. She did not remember the

future for her, and down she goes in a wondrous manner. No comforter does she have. O Yehowah, see my affliction, for the enemy has put on great airs. (Lamentations 1:9)

- And I will scatter you among the nations and disperse you among the lands, and I will destroy your uncleanness out of you. (Ezekiel 22:15)
- Stand it empty upon its coals in order, that it may get hot, and its copper must become heated up, and its uncleanness must be liquefied in the midst of it. Let its rust get consumed. (Ezekiel 24:11)
- There was loose conduct in your uncleanness. For that reason I had to cleanse you, but you did not become clean from your uncleanness. You will become clean no more until I cause my rage to come to its rest in your case. (Ezekiel 24:13)
- Son of man, the house of Israel were dwelling upon their soil, and they kept making it unclean with their way and with their dealings. Like the uncleanness of menstruation their way has become before me. (Ezekiel 36:17)
- According to their uncleanness and according to their transgressions I did with them, and I kept concealing my face from them. (Ezekiel 39:24)
- And it must occur in that day, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, that I shall cut off the names of the idols out of the land, and they will no more be remembered, and also the prophets and the spirit of uncleanness I shall cause to pass out of the land. (Zechariah 13:2)
- Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! Because you resemble whitewashed graves, which outwardly indeed appear beautiful but inside are full of dead mens bones and of every sort of uncleanness. (Matthew 23:27)
- Therefore God, in keeping with the desires of their hearts, gave them up to uncleanness, that their bodies might be dishonored among them. (Romans 1:24)
- I am speaking in human terms because of the weakness of your flesh, for even as you presented your members as slaves to

uncleanness and lawlessness with lawlessness in view, so now present your members as slaves to righteousness with holiness in view. (Romans 6:19)

- Perhaps, when I come again, my God might humiliate me among you, and I might mourn over many of those who formerly sinned but have not repented over their uncleanness and fornication and loose conduct that they have practiced. (2 Corinthians 12:21)
- Now the works of the flesh are manifest, and they are fornication, uncleanness, loose conduct. (Galatians 5:19)
- Having come to be past all moral sense, they gave themselves over to loose conduct to work uncleanness of every sort with greediness. (Ephesians 4:19)
- Let fornication and uncleanness of every sort or greediness not even be mentioned among you, just as it befits holy people. (Ephesians 5:3)
- Deaden, therefore, your body members that are upon the earth as respects fornication, uncleanness, sexual appetite, hurtful desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. (Colossians 3:5)
- For the exhortation we give does not arise from error or from uncleanness or with deceit. (1 Thessalonians 2:3)
- For God called us, not with allowance for uncleanness, but in connection with sanctification. (1 Thessalonians 4:7)
