[English, tired, tired out, sleepy, exhausted, worn out, fatigued, drained, drowsy, Opposite of, refreshed]

- How he met you in the way and proceeded to strike in the rear of you all those straggling after you, while you were exhausted and weary, and he did not fear God. (Deuteronomy 25:18)
- After that they returned to Joshua and said to him; Let not all the people go up. Let about two thousand men or about three thousand men go up and strike Ai. Do not weary all the people with going there, for they are few. (Joshua 7:3)
- And Jael the wife of Heber proceeded to take a pin of the tent and to put the hammer into her hand. Then she went to him stealthily and drove the pin into his temples and beat it into the earth, while he was fast asleep and weary. So he died. (Judges 4:21)
- And I shall come upon him when he is weary and feeble in both hands, and I shall certainly drive him into trembling, and all the people that are with him will have to flee, and I shall certainly strike down the king by himself. (2 Samuel 17:2)
- There the wicked themselves have ceased from agitation, and there those weary in power are at rest. (Job 3:17)
- If one does try out a word to you, will you become weary? But to put a restraint on words who is able? (Job 4:2)
- But this time it comes to you, and you become weary, it touches even you, and you get disturbed. (Job 4:5)
- Only now he has made me weary, he has made all those assembling with me desolate. (Job 16:7)
- I have grown weary with my sighing, all night long I make my couch swim, with my tears I make my own divan overflow.

 (Psalms 6:6)
- A copious downpour you began causing to fall, O God, your inheritance, even when it was weary, you yourself reinvigorated

it. (Psalms 68:9)

- The lazy one has hidden his hand in the banquet bowl, he has become too weary to bring it back to his mouth. (Proverbs 26:15)
- The hard work of the stupid ones makes them weary, because not one has come to know how to go to the city. (Ecclesiastes 10:15)
- And it occurred that it was seen that Moab was made weary upon the high place, and he came to his sanctuary to pray, and he could not accomplish anything. (Isaiah 16:12)
- Those to whom he has said; This is the resting-place. Give rest to the weary one. And this is the place of ease, but who were not willing to hear. (Isaiah 28:12)
- Have you not come to know or have you not heard? Yehowah, the Creator of the extremities of the earth, is a God to time indefinite. He does not tire out or grow weary. There is no searching out of his understanding. (Isaiah 40:28)
- Boys will both tire out and grow weary, and young men themselves will without fail stumble. (Isaiah 40:30)
- But those who are hoping in Yehowah will regain power. They will mount up with wings like eagles. They will run and not grow weary. They will walk and not tire out. (Isaiah 40:31)
- But you have not called even me, O Jacob, because you have grown weary of me, O Israel. (Isaiah 43:22)
- You have not brought me the sheep of your whole burnt offerings, and with your sacrifices you have not glorified me. I have not compelled you to serve me with a gift, nor have I made you weary with frankincense. (Isaiah 43:23)
- For me you have bought no sweet cane with any money, and with the fat of your sacrifices you have not saturated me. In reality you have compelled me to serve because of your sins. You have made me weary with your errors. (Isaiah 43:24)
- You have grown weary with the multitude of your counselors. Let them stand up, now, and save you, the worshipers of the

heavens, the lookers at the stars, those giving out knowledge at the new moons concerning the things that will come upon you. (Isaiah 47:13)

- And with the rage of Yehowah I have become full. I have become weary with holding in. Pour it out upon the child in the street and upon the intimate group of young men at the same time, for they will also be caught, a man along with his wife, an old man along with one that is full of days. (Jeremiah 6:11)
- You have said; Woe, now, to me, for Yehowah has added grief to my pain! I have grown weary because of my sighing, and no resting-place have I found. (Jeremiah 45:3)
- Close onto our neck we have been pursued. We have grown weary. No rest has been left for us. (Lamentations 5:5)
- And while I was yet speaking in the prayer, why, the man Gabriel, whom I had seen in the vision at the start, having been made weary with tiredness, was arriving by me at the time of the evening gift offering. (Daniel 9:21)
- You people have made Yehowah weary by your words, and you have said; In what way have we made him weary? By your saying; Everyone that is doing bad is good in the eyes of Yehowah, and in such ones he himself has taken delight, or, Where is the God of justice? (Malachi 2:17)
- You are also showing endurance, and you have borne up for my names sake and have not grown weary. (Revelation 2:3)
