

**~WILLING ## (138)**

**[English, eager, keen, enthusiastic, ready, prepared, agreeable, disposed, Opposite of, **reluctant**]**

- Then they called Rebekah and said to her; Will you go with this man? In turn she said; I am **willing** to go. (**Genesis 24:58**)
- And Jacob was in love with Rachel. So he said; I am **willing** to serve you seven years for Rachel your younger daughter. (**Genesis 29:18**)
- Raise very high the marriage money and gift imposed upon me, and I stand **willing** to give according to what you may say to me, only give me the young woman as a wife. (**Genesis 34:12**)
- If you are sending our brother with us, we are **willing** to go down and buy food for you. (**Genesis 43:4**)
- Finally Israel said to Joseph; This time I am **willing** to die, now that I have seen your face, since you are still alive. (**Genesis 46:30**)
- My father made me swear, saying; Look! I am dying. In my burial place which I have excavated for myself in the land of Canaan is where you are to bury me. And now, please, let me go up and bury my father, after which I am **willing** to return. (**Genesis 50:5**)
- Entreat Yehowah that this may be enough of the occurring of God's thunders and hail. Then I am **willing** to send you away, and you will not stay any longer. (**Exodus 9:28**)
- After that all the people answered unanimously and said; All that Yehowah has spoken we are **willing** to do. Immediately Moses took back the words of the people to Yehowah. (**Exodus 19:8**)
- Then Moses came and related to the people all the words of Yehowah and all the judicial decisions, and all the people answered with one voice and said; All the words that Yehowah has spoken we are **willing** to do. (**Exodus 24:3**)
- Finally he took the book of the covenant and read it in the ears of

- the people. Then they said; All that Yehowah has spoken we are **willing** to do and be obedient. (**Exodus 24:7**)
- And David was not **willing** to remove the ark of Yehowah to him at the City of David. So David had it carried aside to the house of Obed-edom the Gittite. (**2 Samuel 6:10**)
  - And I was **willing** to give you the house of your lord and the wives of your lord into your bosom, and to give you the house of Israel and of Judah. And if it were not enough, I was willing to add to you things like these as well as other things. (**2 Samuel 12:8**)
  - And here are the divisions of the priests and of the Levites for all the service of the house of the true God, and with you in all the work there is every **willing** one with skill for all the service, and also the princes and all the people, for all your words. (**1 Chronicles 28:21**)
  - Finally Hezekiah answered and said; Now you have filled your hand with power for Yehowah. Approach, and bring sacrifices and thanksgiving sacrifices to the house of Yehowah. And the congregation began to bring sacrifices and thanksgiving sacrifices, and also every one **willing** of heart, burnt offerings. (**2 Chronicles 29:31**)
  - By me an order has been put through that everyone in my realm of the people of Israel and their priests and Levites that is **willing** to go to Jerusalem with you should go. (**Ezra 7:13**)
  - Do restore to me the exultation of salvation by you, and may you support me even with a **willing** spirit. (**Psalms 51:12**)
  - Before I knew it, my own soul had put me at the chariots of my **willing** people. (**Song of Solomon 6:12**)
  - How beautiful your steps have become in your sandals, O **willing** daughter! The curvings of your thighs are like ornaments, the work of an artisans hands. (**Song of Solomon 7:1**)
  - Those to whom he has said; This is the resting-place. Give rest to the weary one. And this is the place of ease, but who were not **willing** to hear. (**Isaiah 28:12**)

- For this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, the Holy One of Israel, has said; By coming back and resting you people will be saved. Your mightiness will prove to be simply in keeping undisturbed and in trustfulness. But you were not **willing**. (Isaiah 30:15)

- However, he was not **willing**, but went off and had him thrown into prison until he should pay back what was owing. (Matthew 18:30)
