

~WISHING ## (25)

- But if you keep walking in opposition to me and not **wishing** to listen to me, I shall then have to inflict seven times more blows upon you according to your sins. (**Leviticus 26:21**)
- At that Pilate, **wishing** to satisfy the crowd, released Barabbas to them, and, after having Jesus whipped, he handed him over to be impaled. (**Mark 15:15**)
- And **wishing** to ascertain the cause for which they were accusing him, I brought him down into their Sanhedrin. (**Acts of Apostles 23:28**)
- And because of fearing we might be cast somewhere upon the rocks, they cast out four anchors from the stern and began **wishing** for it to become day. (**Acts of Apostles 27:29**)
- So, then, it depends, not upon the one **wishing** nor upon the one running, but upon God, who has mercy. (**Romans 9:16**)
