**[English, shrivel, wilt, dry up, shrink, droop, fade, Opposite of, bloom]**

- Underneath will his very roots dry up, and, up above, his bough will **wither**. (**Job 18:16**)
- And he will certainly become like a tree planted by streams of water, that gives its own fruit in its season and the foliage of which does not **wither**, and everything he does will succeed. (**Psalms 1:3**)
- For like grass they will speedily **wither**, and like green new grass they will fade away. (**Psalms 37:2**)
- When doing the gathering, I shall bring them to their finish, is the utterance of Yehowah. There will be no grapes on the vine, and there will be no figs on the fig tree, and the foliage itself will certainly **wither**. And things that I give to them will pass by them. (**Jeremiah 8:13**)
