**[English, speculating, doubting, questioning, being unsure, conjecturing]**

- And its father and mother continued **wondering** at the things being spoken about it. (**Luke 2:33**)
- But while they were still not believing for sheer joy and were **wondering**, he said to them; Do you have something there to eat? (**Luke 24:41**)
- Therefore the Jews fell to **wondering**, saying; How does this man have a knowledge of letters, when he has not studied at the schools? (**John 7:15**)
- In answer Jesus said to them; One deed I performed, and you are all **wondering**. (**John 7:21**)
- When Peter saw this, he said to the people; Men of Israel, why are you **wondering** over this, or why are you gazing at us as though by personal power or godly devotion we have made him walk? (**Acts of Apostles 3:12**)
- Now when they beheld the outspokenness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were men unlettered and ordinary, they got to **wondering**. And they began to recognize about them that they used to be with Jesus. (**Acts of Apostles 4:13**)
