

~**WORTHY (136)**

[English, commendable, praiseworthy, laudable, admirable, valueable, creditable, precious]

- He that has greater affection for father or mother than for me is not **worthy** of me, and he that has greater affection for son or daughter than for me is not worthy of me. (**Matthew 10:37**)
- And whoever does not accept his torture stake and follow after me is not **worthy** of me. (**Matthew 10:38**)
- Then he said to his slaves, The marriage feast indeed is ready, but those invited were not **worthy**. (**Matthew 22:8**)
- Then those that came up to Jesus began to entreat him earnestly, saying; He is **worthy** of your conferring this upon him. (**Luke 7:4**)
- For that reason I did not consider myself **worthy** to come to you. But say the word, and let my servant be healed. (**Luke 7:7**)
- So stay in that house, eating and drinking the things they provide, for the worker is **worthy** of his wages. Do not be transferring from house to house. (**Luke 10:7**)
- I am no longer **worthy** of being called your son. Make me as one of your hired men. (**Luke 15:19**)
- Then the son said to him, Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. I am no longer **worthy** of being called your son. Make me as one of your hired men. (**Luke 15:21**)
- But those who have been counted **worthy** of gaining that system of things and the resurrection from the dead neither marry nor are given in marriage. (**Luke 20:35**)
- The one coming behind me, but the lace of whose sandal I am not **worthy** to untie. (**John 1:27**)
- These, therefore, went their way from before the Sanhedrin, rejoicing because they had been counted **worthy** to be dishonored in behalf of his name. (**Acts of Apostles 5:41**)

- But as John was fulfilling his course, he would say; What do you suppose I am? I am not he. But, look! One is coming after me the sandals of whose feet I am not **worthy** to untie. (**Acts of Apostles 13:25**)
- And so, talking with boldness, Paul and Barnabas said; It was necessary for the word of God to be spoken first to you. Since you are thrusting it away from you and do not judge yourselves **worthy** of everlasting life, look! We turn to the nations. (**Acts of Apostles 13:46**)
- That you may welcome her in the Lord in a way **worthy** of the holy ones, and that you may assist her in any matter where she may need you, for she herself also proved to be a defender of many, yes, of me myself. (**Romans 16:2**)
- Only behave in a manner **worthy** of the Good News about the Christ, in order, that, whether I come and see you or be absent, I may hear about the things which concern you, that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one soul striving side by side for the faith of the Good News. (**Philippians 1:27**)
- This is a proof of the righteous judgment of God, leading to your being counted **worthy** of the kingdom of God, for which you are indeed suffering. (**2 Thessalonians 1:5**)
- To that very end indeed we always pray for you, that our God may count you **worthy** of his calling and perform completely all he pleases of goodness and the work of faith with power. (**2 Thessalonians 1:11**)
- Let the older men who preside in a fine way be reckoned **worthy** of double honor, especially those who work hard in speaking and teaching. (**1 Timothy 5:17**)
- For the scripture says: You must not muzzle a bull when it threshes out the grain. Also: The workman is **worthy** of his wages. (**1 Timothy 5:18**)
- Let as many as are slaves under a yoke keep on considering their owners **worthy** of full honor, that the name of God and the teaching may never be spoken of injuriously. (**1 Timothy 6:1**)
- For the latter is counted **worthy** of more glory than Moses,

inasmuch as he who constructs it has more honor than the house. (**Hebrews 3:3**)

- Of how much more severe a punishment, do you think, will the man be counted **worthy** who has trampled upon the Son of God and who has esteemed as of ordinary value the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and who has outraged the spirit of undeserved kindness with contempt? (**Hebrews 10:29**)
- And the world was not **worthy** of them. They wandered about in deserts and mountains and caves and dens of the earth. (**Hebrews 11:38**)
- Who have borne witness to your love before the congregation. These you will please send on their way in a manner **worthy** of God. (**3 John 1:6**)
- Nevertheless, you do have a few names in Sardis that did not defile their outer garments, and they shall walk with me in white ones, because they are **worthy**. (**Revelation 3:4**)
- You are **worthy**, Yehowah, even our God, to receive the glory and the honor and the power, because you created all things, and because of your will they existed and were created. (**Revelation 4:11**)
- And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice; Who is **worthy** to open the scroll and loose its seals? (**Revelation 5:2**)
- And I gave way to a great deal of weeping because no one was found **worthy** to open the scroll or to look into it. (**Revelation 5:4**)
- And they sing a new song, saying; You are **worthy** to take the scroll and open its seals, because you were slaughtered and with your blood you bought persons for God out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation. (**Revelation 5:9**)
- Saying with a loud voice; The Lamb that was slaughtered is **worthy** to receive the power and riches and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and blessing. (**Revelation 5:12**)
