**[English, aggrieved, mistreated, persecuted, maltreated, victimized, offended, ill-treated]**

- At this David said to Abiathar; I well knew on that day, because Doeg the Edomite was there, that he would without fail tell Saul. I personally have **wronged** every soul of the house of your father. (**1 Samuel 22:22**)
- Really, then, it means altogether a defeat for you that you are having lawsuits with one another. Why do you not rather let yourselves be **wronged**? Why do you not rather let yourselves be defrauded? (**1 Corinthians 6:7**)
- Allow room for us. We have **wronged** no one, we have corrupted no one, we have taken advantage of no one. (**2 Corinthians 7:2**)
- Certainly, although I wrote you, I did it, neither for the one who did the wrong, nor for the one who was **wronged**, but that your earnestness for us might be made manifest among you in the sight of God. (**2 Corinthians 7:12**)
