A poetic shortened form of Yehowah, the name of the Most High God.

- At that time Moses and the sons of Israel proceeded to sing this song to Yehowah and to say the following; Let me sing to Yehowah, for he has become highly exalted the horse and its rider he has pitched into the sea. (Exodus 15:1)
- My strength and my might is Yah, since he serves for my salvation. This is my God, and I shall laud him, my fathers God, and I shall raise him on high. (Exodus 15:2)
- This abbreviated form is represented by the first half of the Hebrew Tetragrammaton *YHWH*, that is, the letters *yohdh* and *he´*, the tenth and fifth letters of the Hebrew alphabet respectively.
