

~YIELD ## (89)

[English, give way, give up, acquiesce, capitulate, defer, surrender, succumb, give in, cede, Opposite of, **resist]**

- In that case I shall certainly command my blessing for you in the sixth year, and it must **yield** its crop for three years. (**Leviticus 25:21**)
- I shall also certainly give your showers of rain at their proper time, and the land will indeed give its **yield**, and the tree of the field will give its fruit. (**Leviticus 26:4**)
- And your power will simply be expended for nothing, as your earth will not give its **yield**, and the tree of the earth will not give its fruit. (**Leviticus 26:20**)
- And with the choice things, the products of the sun, and with the choice things, the **yield** of the lunar months. (**Deuteronomy 33:14**)
- And they began to eat some of the **yield** of the land the day after the Passover, unfermented cakes and roasted grains, on this same day. (**Joshua 5:11**)
- Then the manna ceased on the following day when they had eaten some of the **yield** of the land, and manna did not occur anymore for the sons of Israel, and they began to eat some of the produce of the land of Canaan in that year. (**Joshua 5:12**)
- And they would camp against them and would ruin the **yield** of the earth all the way to Gaza, and they would not let any sustenance or sheep or bull or ass remain in Israel. (**Judges 6:4**)
- And he began to give to the cockroaches their **yield**, and their toil to the locusts. (**Psalms 78:46**)
- Also, Yehowah, for his part, will give what is good, and our own land will give its **yield**. (**Psalms 85:12**)
- And they sow fields and plant vineyards, that they may **yield** fruitful crops. (**Psalms 107:37**)

- Israel was something holy to Yehowah, the first **yield** to Him. Any persons devouring him would make themselves guilty. Calamity itself would come upon them, was the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 2:3**)
- And the tree of the field must give its fruitage, and the land itself will give its **yield**, and they will actually prove to be on their soil in security. And they will have to know that I am Yehowah when I break the bars of their yoke and I have delivered them out of the hand of those who had been using them as slaves. (**Ezekiel 34:27**)
- Although the fig tree itself may not blossom, and there may be no **yield** on the vines, the work of the olive tree may actually turn out a failure, and the terraces themselves may actually produce no food, the flock may actually be severed from the pen, and there may be no herd in the enclosures. (**Habakkuk 3:17**)
- Therefore over you the heavens kept back their dew, and the earth itself kept back its **yield**. (**Haggai 1:10**)
- For there will be the seed of peace, the vine itself will give its fruitage, and the earth itself will give its **yield**, and the heavens themselves will give their dew, and I shall certainly cause the remaining ones of this people to inherit all these things. (**Zechariah 8:12**)
- Still others fell upon the fine soil and they began to **yield** fruit, this one a hundredfold, that one sixty, the other thirty. (**Matthew 13:8**)
- But others fell upon the fine soil, and, coming up and increasing, they began to **yield** fruit, and they were bearing thirtyfold, and sixty and a hundred. (**Mark 4:8**)
- Do not avenge yourselves, beloved, but **yield** place to the wrath, for it is written: Vengeance is mine. I will repay, says Yehowah. (**Romans 12:19**)
- To these we did not **yield** by way of submission, no, not for an hour, in order, that the truth of the Good News might continue with you. (**Galatians 2:5**)
