(Zab'di) [shortened form of Zabdiel]

- A Levite of the sons of Asaph and forefather of Mattaniah, a postexilic music leader.
- And Mattaniah himself, the son of Micah the son of Zabdi the son of Asaph, the conductor of the praise singing, did the lauding at prayer, and Bakbukiah was second of his brothers, and Abda the son of Shammua the son of Galal the son of Jeduthun. (Nehemiah 11:17)
- Zabdi appears to be elsewhere called Zichri.
- And Bakbakkar, Heresh and Galal, and Mattaniah the son of Mica the son of Zichri the son of Asaph. (1 Chronicles 9:15)
- And possibly Zaccur.
- Of the sons of Asaph, Zaccur and Joseph and Nethaniah and Asharelah, the sons of Asaph under the control of Asaph the one prophesying under the control of the king. (1 Chronicles 25:2)
- The third for **Zaccur**, his sons and his brothers, twelve. (1 Chronicles 25:10)
- Also of the sons of the priests with the trumpets Zechariah the son of Jonathan the son of Shemaiah the son of Mattaniah the son of Micaiah the son of Zaccur the son of Asaph. (Nehemiah 12:35)
