

~ZACCUR 6 (25)

(Zac'cur) [from a root meaning, remember]

- **A Levite represented in the signatures to the covenant of faithfulness proposed during Nehemiah's governorship. **Zaccur** may have been there himself, or perhaps one of his descendants signed, in his name.**
- **So in view of all this we are contracting a trustworthy arrangement, both in writing and attested by the seal of our princes, our Levites and our priests. (**Nehemiah 9:38**)**
- **Now attesting it by seal there were. Nehemiah the Tirshatha, the son of Hacaliah, and Zedekiah. (**Nehemiah 10:1**)**
- **Also the Levites, Jeshua the son of Azaniah, Binnui of the sons of Henadad, Kadmiel. (**Nehemiah 10:9**)**
- ****Zaccur**, Sherebiah, Shebaniah. (**Nehemiah 10:12**)**
