(Zac'cur) [from a root meaning, remember]

- A Levite represented in the signatures to the covenant of faithfulness proposed during Nehemiah's governorship. Zaccur may have been there himself, or perhaps one of his descendants signed, in his name.
- So in view of all this we are contracting a trustworthy arrangement, both in writing and attested by the seal of our princes, our Levites and our priests. (Nehemiah 9:38)
- Now attesting it by seal there were. Nehemiah the Tirshatha, the son of Hacaliah, and Zedekiah. (Nehemiah 10:1)
- Also the Levites, Jeshua the son of Azaniah, Binnui of the sons of Henadad, Kadmiel. (Nehemiah 10:9)
- **Zaccur**, Sherebiah, Shebaniah. (Nehemiah 10:12)
