(Za'dok) [from a root meaning, be righteous]

- One of Jerusalem's postexilic wall rebuilders, son of Baana.
- And at their side Meremoth the son of Urijah the son of Hakkoz did repair work, and at their side Meshullam the son of Berechiah the son of Meshezabel did repair work, and at their side Zadok the son of Baana did repair work. (Nehemiah 3:4)
- Either he or a representative of a family of the same name signed the national covenant proposed shortly thereafter.
- So in view of all this we are contracting a trustworthy arrangement, both in writing and attested by the seal of our princes, our Levites and our priests. (Nehemiah 9:38)
- Now attesting it by seal there were. Nehemiah the Tirshatha, the son of Hacaliah, and Zedekiah. (Nehemiah 10:1)
- The heads of the people, Parosh, Pahath-moab, Elam, Zattu, Bani. (Nehemiah 10:14)
- Meshezabel, Zadok, Jaddua. (Nehemiah 10:21)
