## ~ZAMZUMMIM (27)

(Zam-zum'mim) [possibly from a root meaning, have in mind, scheme]

- The Ammonite name for the Rephaim, a people dispossessed by the Ammonites.
- And you must get close in front of the sons of Ammon. Do not molest them or engage in strife with them, because I shall not give you any of the land of the sons of Ammon as a holding, for it is to the sons of Lot that I have given it as a holding.

  (Deuteronomy 2:19)
- As the land of the Rephaim it also used to be considered. The Rephaim dwelt in it in former times, and the Ammonites used to call them Zamzummim. (Deuteronomy 2:20)
- There is no definite connection between them and the Zuzim.
- And in the fourteenth year Chedorlaomer came, and also the kings who were with him, and they inflicted defeats on the Rephaim in Ashterothkarnaim, and the Zuzim in Ham, and the Emim in Shavehkiriathaim. (Genesis 14:5)
