~ZAPHENATH-PANEAH (16) (Zaph'e-nath-pa-ne'ah)

- The name that Pharaoh gave to Joseph when elevating him in authority to a position next to himself.
- After that Pharaoh called Joseph's name Zaphenathpaneah and gave him Asenath the daughter of Potiphera the priest of On as a wife. And Joseph began to go out over the land of Egypt. (Genesis 41:45)
- To those who spoke Hebrew, the pronunciation of the name evidently meant, Revealer of Hidden Things, but to the Egyptians it perhaps meant, The God said; He Will Live!
