~ZATTU (57) (Zat'tu)

- Forefather of a large family that returned to Jerusalem with Zerubbabel in 537 B.C.E.
- And these were the sons of the jurisdictional district that went up out of the captivity of the exiled people whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had taken into exile at Babylon and who later returned to Jerusalem and Judah, each one to his own city. (Ezra 2:1)
- Those who came with Zerubbabel, Jeshua, Nehemiah, Seraiah, Reelaiah, Mordecai, Bilshan, Mispar, Bigvai, Rehum, Baanah. The number of the men of the people of Israel. (Ezra 2:2)
- The sons of Zattu, nine hundred and forty-five. (Ezra 2:8)
- The sons of **Zattu**, eight hundred and forty-five. (Nehemiah 7:13)
- When Ezra came to Jerusalem some of their descendants dismissed the foreign wives they had taken.
- At length Ezra the priest rose and said to them; You yourselves have acted unfaithfully in that you gave a dwelling to foreign wives so as to add to the guiltiness of Israel. (Ezra 10:10)
- And now make confession to Yehowah the God of your forefathers and do his pleasure and separate yourselves from the peoples of the land and from the foreign wives. (Ezra 10:11)
- And of the sons of **Zattu**, Elioenai, Eliashib, Mattaniah and Jeremoth and **Zabad** and **Aziza**. (**Ezra 10:27**)
- These all had accepted foreign wives, and they proceeded to send away wives along with sons. (Ezra 10:44)
- Shortly thereafter, a representative of this family, or someone else named Zattu, sealed the trustworthy arrangement.
- So in view of all this we are contracting a trustworthy arrangement, both in writing and attested by the seal of our

princes, our Levites and our priests. (Nehemiah 9:38)

- Now attesting it by seal there were, Nehemiah the Tirshatha, the son of Hacaliah, and Zedekiah. (Nehemiah 10:1)
- The heads of the people, Parosh, Pahath-moab, Elam, Zattu, Bani. (Nehemiah 10:14)
