~**ZEBEDEE** (92)

(Zeb'e-dee) [possibly from a Hebrew root meaning, endow]

- Father of Jesus apostles James and John.
- Going on also from there he saw two others who were brothers, James the son of **Zebedee** and John his brother, in the boat with **Zebedee** their father, mending their nets, and he called them. (Matthew 4:21)
- At once leaving the boat and their father, they followed him. (Matthew 4:22)
- The names of the twelve apostles are these, first, Simon, the one called Peter, and Andrew his brother, and James the son of **Zebedee** and John his brother. (Matthew 10:2)
- And taking along Peter and the two sons of **Zebedee**, he started to be grieved and to be sorely troubled. (Matthew 26:37)
- And James the son of **Zebedee** and John the brother of James, he also gave these the surname Boanerges, which means Sons of Thunder. (Mark 3:17)
- And James and John, the two sons of **Zebedee**, stepped up to him and said to him; Teacher, we want you to do for us whatever it is we ask you for. (Mark 10:35)
- And likewise both James and John, **Zebedees** sons, who were sharers with Simon. But Jesus said to Simon; Stop being afraid. From now on you will be catching men alive. (Luke 5:10)
- There were in company Simon Peter and Thomas, who was called The Twin, and Nathanael from Cana of Galilee and the sons of **Zebedee** and two others of his disciples. (**John 21:2**)
- Zebedees wife Salome is generally believed to have been the sister of Jesus mother Mary. This would mean that Zebedee was Jesus uncle by marriage, and James and John, Jesus cousins.
- Among whom was Mary Magdalene, also Mary the mother of James and Joses, and the mother of the sons of **Zebedee**.

(Matthew 27:56)

- There were also women viewing from a distance, among them Mary Magdalene as well as Mary the mother of James the Less and of Joses, and Salome. (Mark 15:40)
- By the torture stake of Jesus, however, there were standing his mother and the sister of his mother, Mary the wife of Clopas, and Mary Magdalene. (John 19:25)

- Zebedee was in the fishing business on the Sea of Galilee and apparently did quite well with it, for there were hired men working with him.
- While walking alongside the sea of Galilee he saw Simon and Andrew the brother of Simon casting their nets about in the sea, for they were fishers. (Mark 1:16)
- And after going a little farther he saw James the son of **Zebedee** and John his brother, in fact, while they were in their boat mending their nets. (Mark 1:19)
- And without delay he called them. In turn they left their father **Zebedee** in the boat with the hired men and went off after him. (Mark 1:20)
- His wife Salome was able to render material services to Jesus.
- There were also women viewing from a distance, among them Mary Magdalene as well as Mary the mother of James the Less and of Joses, and Salome. (Mark 15:40)
- Who used to accompany him and minister to him when he was in Galilee, and many other women who had come up together with him to Jerusalem. (Mark 15:41)
- So while there is no indication that **Zebedee** himself followed Christ, his family freely did so.
- Then the mother of the sons of **Zebedee** approached him with her sons, doing obeisance and asking for something from him. (Matthew 20:20)
