(Zech-a-ri'ah) [Yehowah Has Remembered]

- A Levite gatekeeper also commended as a counselor with discretion. He had been a gatekeeper at the entrance of the tent of meeting, and when David reorganized the Levitical services for the future temple, Zechariah's lot fell to the north.
- He was the firstborn son of Meshelemiah, a Korahite, in the Kohathite family of Levites.
- **Zechariah** the son of Meshelemiah was the gatekeeper of the entrance of the tent of meeting. (1 Chronicles 9:21)
- All of them who were selected as gatekeepers at the thresholds were two hundred and twelve. They were in their settlements by their genealogical enrollment. These David and Samuel the seer ordained in their office of trust. (1 Chronicles 9:22)
- For the divisions of gatekeepers. Of the Korahites, Meshelemiah the son of Kore of the sons of Asaph. (1 Chronicles 26:1)
- And Meshelemiah had sons, Zechariah the firstborn, Jediael the second, Zebadiah the third, Jathniel the fourth. (1 Chronicles 26:2)
- Then the lot to the east fell to Shelemiah. For Zechariah his son, a counselor with discretion, they cast the lots, and his lot got to come out to the north. (1 Chronicles 26:14)
